Let's go to a place almost no one **reads**, a list of **names**. *Romans 16*

Most of the early churches were planted, sustained, and kept in communication through **ordinary** people!

There was no **divorce** between their **travel** life, their **business** life, and their life as a **follower** of Jesus!

*Acts 8:4* wasn't just a one time thing, but **wherever** they went, and **why-ever** they went, they shared their faith in Jesus!

How does this **matter**?

“I am your **sister**. You are the **answer** to my **prayer**!”

So much of our Shift emphasis boils down to our commitment to live **intentionally**, to **GO**\_fearlessly **with** Jesus!
